



# REVIVE ME, REVIVE THEM

## TEACH ME

### Lesson

Children need to be included when it comes to focusing on revival. Revival goes beyond receiving the Holy Spirit; it includes spending time with God in such a way that we become more like Him - truly transformed. Scripture teaches us that we become like whatever we spend our time and effort on. So, let's actively train our children to spend time with an amazing God.

We know that Bible reading is essential in this, as well as prayer. However, we need to train our children to talk to God all throughout their day, instead of teaching them mere habitual praying. Explain how God wants a relationship with them, like a real friend.

*Here are some ways you can train them to include God more often:*

- Talk about their day with them, and share those things with God.
- Go on a nature walk and stop to talk to God about what they see.
- Train them to talk to God about things that upset them.
- Have them share their life dreams and imaginations with Him.
- Randomly have praise breaks that thank Him for something different.
- Talk to God in front of them in a normal conversational manner.
- As you are driving, talk with God together about what you see.
- Have them use song, art, or writing in communication with Him.

As you do these things, you will get closer to God, and so will they.

## SHOW ME

### Activity

Materials needed: popcorn

- If you have multiple children, divide them equally and have them stand facing each other, about 10 feet apart. Each child will need to be facing another child. If you have an unequal number of children, or only one child, you will need to stand in as a participant. The children will be tossing popcorn pieces.
- Give all the children a piece of popcorn and have them toss it to the person across from them, and then, vice versa. See who can catch the popcorn piece that was tossed to them. Note: it will be hard to get a single piece of popcorn to toss the full 10 feet, so encourage the children to keep trying.
- Have the children get a few inches/feet closer, and toss the popcorn again. Continue to this until the children are very close.
- Explain how our relationship with God is similar to the activity. The further away from each other, the harder it is to catch the popcorn. Likewise, the further we are from God, the harder it is to have a relationship with Him. The closer we are to God, the easier it is to have a strong relationship with Him. How do we get close to God? By reading the Bible, praying, fasting, and by including Him in all parts of our everyday life, like a real friend.

## TRAIN ME

### Prayer Time

- Ask God to help you find ways to incorporate random and purposeful interaction with Him in your home more often.
- Talk to Him without asking Him for anything. Talk about things you would talk to your friends and family about. He cares about all parts of your life.
